Call and Response Song

A call and response song is a type of musical dialogue. One person or a group of people sing a musical phrase, and someone else or a group of people responds by echoing the same phrase or singing a different phrase back.

This is “Hallelu, hallelu, hallelu, Hallelujah” as a call and response song. One group will sing the words that are not italicised and another group the italicised words. This song can be even more fun if the group singing jumps up when it is their turn to sing.
