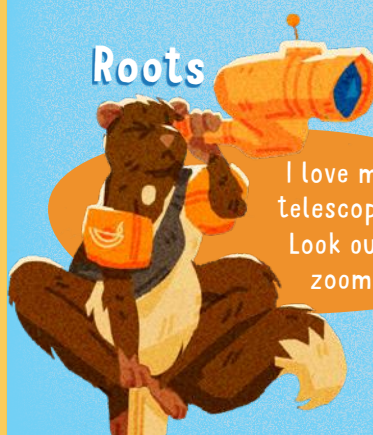

This is the Ancient Sketchbook

On our last journey, we learned that when God created our world, everything was **very good**. Then it happened—Adam and Eve disobeyed and everything changed. But God would not give up on them. He promised that someday he would send someone who would make everything good again. And then, we met Jesus, the Messiah, on our first journey when he was a baby and a young boy. What will they do when they encounter Jesus, the Messiah, who has come to bring them back to God?

TRIP 1: A VOICE IN THE WILDERNESS

In Journey 1, we learned about two important babies: John and Jesus. John's parents were told that he would prepare people for the coming of the Lord, while Mary was told that her son, Jesus, was the Son of God and would be a great king. In this journey we'll visit John and Jesus but now they are all grown up.

PRAY: Ask God to help you discover more about him in the Bible today.

Let's open the Ancient Sketchbook. It's time for another trip!

I think that's John, but he's not a baby anymore!

Let's get going! We're off to the wilderness in Judea today!

LOCATION:

JUDEAN WILDERNESS

DAY 1

John is around 30 years old now and he is preaching in the wilderness. He has a special task to do for God and a special message to give the people.

Read Mark 1:1-8

DAY 2

Read Mark 1:1-3

Around 700 years earlier, these words were written about a messenger who would prepare the people for God's coming. Now it was finally coming true!

DAY 3 Read Mark 1:4-5

John's message was that people should repent—turn away from their sins and back to God. In baptism, they were dipped under the water as a sign of cleansing and a fresh start.

DAY 4

Read Mark 1:6

John's appearance and diet were quite unusual (and that camel hair sounds scratchy!). Why do you think he dressed and ate like that?

DAY 5

Read Mark 1:7-8

John understood that it was not about him being seen as great. The whole point of what he was doing was to point towards someone even greater.

DAYS 6&7

John talked about someone greater who was coming soon. On our next trip we'll find out more about that. Who do you think it could be? It is time to **think** about this trip, **write** in your Landers Log, and **talk** to your Travel Guide.

It was an honour to be God's messenger and to help prepare people for the one who was coming. I couldn't wait to see what happened when he arrived!

It's time to go back home and think about what we discovered.

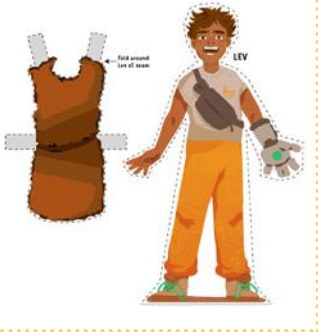

DAY 2

Read Mark 1:9

Jesus travelled all the way from Nazareth to be baptised by John. It was like a family reunion, but in a river!

DAY 3

Read Mark 1:10

When Jesus came out of the water, a lot happened! The clouds opened and the Spirit of God came down. God was there with him!

DAY 5

Read Mark 1:12-13

In the wilderness, Jesus was tempted by Satan just like the serpent in the Garden of Eden from Journey 2. How do you think Jesus is going to act?

DAY 4

Read Mark 1:11

What a lovely thing for God to say about Jesus! We can know for sure that Jesus is God's Son and that he loves him very much.

DAYS 6&7

On our next trip, we'll find out what happens in the wilderness and how Jesus responds to what Satan does. Do you think he'll be different from Adam and Eve?

It is time to **think** about this trip, **write** in your Landers Log, and **talk** to your Travel Guide.

I didn't know what to expect when I came down to the river today, but I was blown away! Seeing the Holy Spirit come down, hearing God's voice from heaven—Jesus really is someone special!

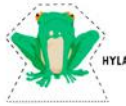

BAPTISM—what is it? Baptism is a symbol of being made clean from sin and is a public declaration of faith in Jesus. It was also used in certain Jewish cleansing rituals. Water has been used in baptisms for hundreds of years in all kinds of ways. It is typically performed by sprinkling, pouring, or by dipping a person all the way under the water.

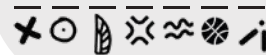

DAY 1

Read Matthew 4:1-11

DAY 2

Read Matthew 4:1-4

Forty days without food? Jesus must have been so hungry! The devil tried to use that against him, but Jesus used God's Word (from the Old Testament) to fight him off.

DAY 3

Read Matthew 4:5-7

The devil is sneaky! This time, he tried to use God's Word, but he was twisting it.

Jesus knew better and proved him wrong again!

DAY 4

Read Matthew 4:8-10

The devil said he could give Jesus all the kingdoms if he worshipped him. But Jesus knew that God is the only one to be worshipped, and that all the kingdoms belong to Him.

DAY 5

Read Matthew 4:11

Jesus won! Where Adam and Eve couldn't fight the devil off, Jesus did. He knew God and his word and didn't waver from his commitment to both. The devil gives up when we trust God fully.

DAYS 6&7

Jesus has been busy! After his baptism and the showdown in the wilderness, the rest of the work of sharing the Good News really begins. We'll find out more on our next trip! It is time to **think** about this trip, **write** in your Landers Log, and **talk** to your Travel Guide.

DAY 5

Read John 2:11

Jesus' disciples believed in him because of this wonderful sign. They had seen a glimpse of his glory, and they were discovering that he was someone very special!

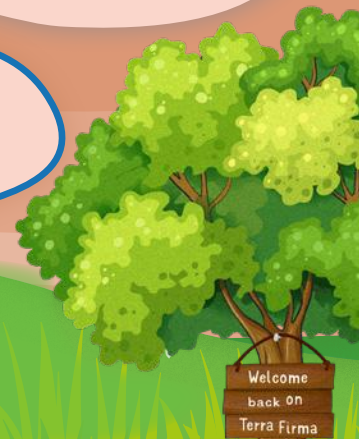
DAYS 6 & 7

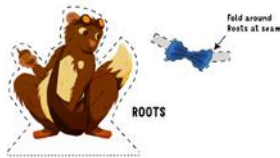

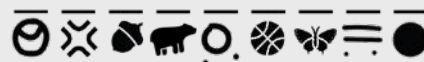
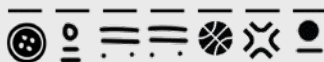

DAY 2
Read John 2:13-14

Passover was a time when everyone was supposed to remember God's rescue of his people when they were slaves in Egypt. But when Jesus arrived, they were busy buying and selling things!

DAY 3
Read John 2:15

The money changers were cheating the people, and others were charging high prices for the animals the people needed for their worship of God. Jesus was angry!

DAY 4
Read John 2:16

Jesus was upset because the Temple was his Father's house and should have been a place of prayer and worship, not a market!

What a mess! Jesus really felt strongly about what was happening. I think he had a good point though. The Temple was being used all wrong.

Read John 2:17

Jesus' disciples remembered words from the Psalms that said Jesus would feel very strongly about the Temple, his Father's house! They understood, but many others didn't realise what was going on.

Let's get back and think about all of this!

DAYS 6&7 Some of the things that Jesus did confused or upset people, especially the really religious people. But one of them was actually interested in learning more. Roman Centurion



DAY 1

A centurion was somebody very powerful—an officer responsible for many Roman soldiers. But this is a centurion who knows he needs Jesus' help.

Read Matthew 8:5-13

DAY 4

Read Matthew 8:10-12

Jesus was amazed that someone who was not a Jew had such faith. The religious leaders hadn't believed, even after seeing miracles. But this centurion trusted him!

DAY 5 Read Matthew 8:13

The centurion was right! Jesus didn't have to go to his servant, he only had to say the word. In an instant he was healed. What amazing faith!

DAYS 6&7

Jesus mentioned three men who lived a long time before him—Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. Who are they? Why did he talk about them? We will find out on Journey 4! It is time to **think** about this trip, **write** in your Landers Log, and **talk** to your Travel Guide.

DAY 2

Read Matthew 8:5-7

The news about Jesus had spread far—even beyond the Jews! The Roman centurion had heard about Jesus' miracles, and he had faith that Jesus could heal his servant.

DAY 3

Read Matthew 8:8-9

The centurion knew if he told his soldiers to do something, they would obey. He believed Jesus was even more powerful and could heal his servant just by speaking!

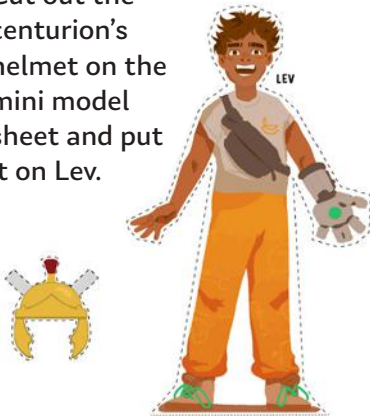
