Day 6: Think about the Bible story and what we learned about God and ourselves.

Day 7: Talk to others about what you learned.

Finish the trip by putting a travel stamp in your passport.




G'day Timelanders.




Tip#4



TRIP 1: THE NEW NAME AND NEW START

On our last Journey, we met Jacob and Esau—two brothers who fought and quarrelled but who finally became friends. Along the way, Jacob was changed by encountering God and deciding to follow him, but it won't always be an easy journey. Let's find out what happens to Jacob and his big family.

PRAY: Ask God to help you get to know him more as you read the Bible.



And we're back into the vortex, whizzing back in time!



I've got the Ancient Sketchbook. I can't wait to go on our next adventure!

DAY 1 After his meeting with Esau, Jacob has returned to Bethel, the place where he met with God before. Just as God promised, Jacob now has a big family, and another son is on the way. But there are some changes coming that won't be so happy.
Read Genesis 35:9–29

DAY 2
Read Genesis 35:9–15
God reminded Jacob of his new name, Israel—one who struggles with God and prevails—and he repeated his promise that Jacob's family would become a great nation.

DAY 3
Read Genesis 35:16–20
As they travelled from Bethel, Jacob had the joy of his son Benjamin being born. But he also had the sorrow of seeing his beloved wife, Rachel, die.

DAY 4
Read Genesis 35:23–26
Altogether Jacob had twelve sons. Their families would become what is known as the twelve tribes of Israel. This was the start of the new nation God was forming.

In the sorrow of losing my family members, and my joy over my new son and making up with Esau, God was always with me, reminding me of his promises.

DAY 5 **Read Genesis 35:27–29**
Soon after Jacob lost his wife, his father, Isaac, also died. It must have comforted him that he and Esau had made up and they could bury their father together.



Did you know?

This is not the only time God introduces himself as 'GOD ALMIGHTY'. In the Hebrew language it is 'El Shaddai'. This title for God appears right through the Bible from Genesis to Revelation. It means that God is all-powerful, cannot be stopped from doing his will, and is the creator and sustainer of all things. Another word for this is 'omnipotent'.




PRAY: Do you ever feel jealous when you think that someone else is getting special treatment? Talk to God about it and ask him to help you.

Read Genesis 37:1–18




I can see lots of people. I think they might be Jacob's sons.

Reuben persuaded his brothers not to kill Joseph. He didn't want to tell them, but he felt bad about it all and planned to come back later to rescue Joseph.



• **PLAY A GAME OF FLIP THE TARP**, where everyone must work together instead of putting themselves first! You and a group of friends will stand together on a sheet, tarp or blanket. Now, work together to figure out how to flip over the sheet, tarp or blanket without anyone stepping off or touching the ground! To increase the challenge, try to do it more quickly each time.

• **MAKE YOUR OWN PIZZA SEASONING** to explore spices in the kitchen! Use measuring spoons to measure out into a bowl: 2 tablespoons dried oregano, 2 tablespoons dried basil, 1 teaspoon garlic powder, and 1 teaspoon dried thyme. 

DAY 1 After being taken to Egypt, Joseph is sold as a slave to a man called Potiphar. Everything is going great until something happens that Joseph can do nothing about.


Read Genesis 39:1-23

The only thing I have to take care of is having enough flies to eat!



DAY 2 Potiphar thought Joseph was a good and faithful worker! Over time he gave Joseph more responsibility for the household. It was all because God was with Joseph, helping him succeed. **Read Genesis 39:1-5**

Yes! I wonder how Joseph is getting on. He's so far from home now!



DAY 3 Joseph was under pressure! Potiphar's wife kept trying to get him to do what he knew was wrong, but Joseph was determined not to give in. **Read Genesis 39:6-10**

Joseph was such a faithful worker. I was shocked when I heard my wife's story and was sure she wouldn't lie to me. How could Joseph do that?

DAY 4 This was so unfair! Joseph had done nothing wrong. Potiphar's wife made up a false story to get him into trouble. Surely Potiphar would realise it wasn't true? **Read Genesis 39:11-18**





TRIP 5: THROUGH THICK AND THIN



Are you ready to see what happens next with Joseph?

DAY 2

Read Genesis 41:15-21 Seven fat cows and seven thin cows—that was a very weird dream! But Joseph was confident God would help him to understand the meaning.

Yes, and I hope he gets out of prison.

DAY 3

Read Genesis 41:22-27

The second dream was also very odd, and Pharaoh's magicians had no idea what it meant. Joseph knew straight away that God was showing Pharaoh the future.

DAY 4

Read Genesis 41:28-36

Seven years of famine would be a disaster for Egypt and would leave everyone starving, but knowing it was coming meant they could store food and be ready.

DAY 5

Read Genesis 41:37-43

Joseph had always been clear that his wisdom came from God. Pharaoh recognised this and Joseph suddenly went from being a prisoner to being second-in-command in Egypt!

It's time to go back home and think about what we discovered.

Joseph's ability to understand dreams was amazing! I knew that God was with him and that if anyone could help Pharaoh it would be Joseph!

- **MAKE BRICKS FROM MUD AND STRAW** like the Israelites in Egypt! You are going to need: mud, straw, and a mold such as a loaf pan or milk carton. It is best to do this outdoors on a sunny day. In a bucket or large container, mix dirt (with 25-50% clay if possible) and water to make the mud until it is thick, like cookie dough. Add and knead in some chopped straw. Pack the mixture firmly into the mold. Let brick sit in mold briefly, then remove onto a flat sunny surface. Repeat until all the mixture is gone. Dry the bricks in the sun for a week or more, turning them periodically to dry all sides.
- **PLAY PASS THE BABY MOSES** (like Pass the Potato). To start the game, players will sit or stand in a circle. One person starts the music. A baby doll is passed around the circle while the music is playing. As soon as the music stops, the person holding the baby is 'out.' The game continues in rounds until only one person is left. You can make the game more difficult by requiring players to pass the baby doll with only one hand or while standing on one foot, for example.

Moses obeyed God and went back to Egypt, but Pharaoh refused to let the Israelites go free. God sent nine plagues on the Egyptians including frogs, gnats, and hail. But Pharaoh continues to be stubborn until God sends the tenth and final plague. It will be so horrible that, after this, the Israelites will finally be free to leave Egypt.

PRAY: Thank God for his power to rescue and ask him to help you learn more about it.

It looks like we're going back to Egypt to see Moses again.

EGYPT

DAY 1 Even though Pharaoh refused to let the Israelites go, they had to prepare to leave Egypt. Before God sends the last plague on the Egyptians, he has some very important instructions for the Israelites. Obeying was extremely important—it was a matter of life and death!

DAY 2 Read Exodus 12:1–13

Each family had to smear blood around their doorframe indicating they were choosing life. Just like we pack our bags for travel, tucking their cloak under their belt and putting on sandals meant they were ready to go!

I wonder if he managed to persuade Pharaoh to let the Israelites go free.

Aaron Pharaoh was being so difficult! I knew the final plague was going to be serious and we had to listen carefully to God's instructions.

DAY 3

Read Exodus 12:14–20

The Israelites were told to celebrate at the same time every year to remember how God rescued them. This part of the celebration would be known as the 'Festival of Unleavened Bread'.



DAY 5

Read Exodus 12:29–36

The last plague was devastating to all the Egyptians from the powerful to the least of them. It all came true just as God told Moses it would—including the Egyptians giving them silver, gold, and clothing!



DAY 4

Read Exodus 12:21–28

Moses and Aaron gave their final instructions to get everyone ready. This night will forever be remembered as the 'Passover' when the Israelites are saved by the blood on their doorframes.





Did you know? YEAST are tiny living organisms that are a type of fungus. They are used in making bread. When yeast mixes with flour, water, and sugar, the yeast consumes the sugar and produces carbon dioxide gas. The carbon dioxide gas bubbles cause the bread dough to rise. Bread without yeast is called unleavened bread.

What an amazing miracle! Moses raised his staff over the sea, and a dry path appeared. What do you think it was like to walk through the middle of the sea?

DAY 5

Read Exodus 14:26-31

God fought for the Israelites, and the Egyptians were defeated. After seeing God's power, the Israelites put their trust in him and in Moses as their leader.





• MAKE A SEA IN A BOTTLE. You can use any kind of plastic bottle (soda, water, etc.). Fill it about a third of the way up with water, add some blue food colouring, and mix it together. Then fill the bottle the rest of the way with clear oil (baby oil, mineral oil, or cooking oil). Ensure you fill it all the way to the top. Secure the lid tightly (with glue if you are concerned it may leak). Turn the bottle on its side and tip the bottle from side to side to see the sway of the sea!
